ABOUT THIS POLICY

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how AFRIKARS uses cookies and similar technologies across our cross-border vehicle marketplace, website, mobile applications and related services (the "Platform"), what each category of cookie does, and how you can accept, reject or change your choices at any time.

PLAIN-LANGUAGE SUMMARY

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. We use them to keep the Platform working and secure, to remember your preferences, and — only with your consent — to understand how the Platform is used and to measure our advertising. You can accept, reject or customise non-essential cookies at any time through our cookie banner or the Cookie Preferences setting. Rejecting them will not stop you using the Platform, but some features may work less well.

SECTION 01

Who we are and what this policy covers

This Cookie Policy is issued by **AFRIKARS INC.**, a Delaware corporation and the holding company of the Afrikars group. In this policy, "AFRIKARS", "we", "us" and "our" refer to AFRIKARS INC. and the companies it holds. AFRIKARS INC. is the controller of the personal data described here.

This policy explains how we use cookies and similar technologies on www.afrikars.com and our related services. Our mobile applications use similar technologies, such as device identifiers and local storage, for the same purposes described below.

This policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, at www.afrikars.com/privacy, which explains how we handle personal data generally, the legal bases we rely on, how long we keep data, and the rights you have over it.

SECTION 02

What cookies are

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. For example, cookies are used to remember users' preferences and to help navigate between pages efficiently.

A cookie does not by itself tell us your name or email address. However, the identifiers cookies contain, and the information we collect alongside them, can constitute personal data under applicable data protection law. We handle that information in accordance with our Privacy Policy, and we do not share it with any third party other than as stated there.

We may also automatically receive and record information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address and the page you requested.

Cookies will typically contain details such as the domain from which the cookie has come, a value which is usually a random unique number used as an identifier, and the lifetime — the expiry — of the cookie.

What will a cookie do for me?

Almost every website that offers advanced features such as online ordering or quoting and custom content uses cookies. Each website uses its own cookies, which essentially means that the cookies used by one site cannot be used by another.

SECTION 03

Types of cookies we use

The Platform uses different categories of cookies to provide a secure, functional and user-friendly browsing experience. Depending on your preferences, we may use the following types of cookies.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Platform and enable core functionality such as page navigation, security, authentication, and access to secure areas. Without these cookies, the Platform cannot function properly. Examples include:

- maintaining your browsing session;
- user authentication;
- security and fraud prevention;
- load balancing; and
- remembering your cookie consent preferences.

These cookies do not require your consent, as they are necessary for the provision of our services.

Functional (preference) cookies

Functional cookies enable the Platform to remember information about your preferences and choices, in order to provide a more personalised experience. Examples include:

- remembering your preferred language;
- saving accessibility settings;
- remembering your region or location; and
- retaining display preferences.

These cookies are only used with your consent.

Analytics (performance) cookies

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Platform by collecting information about how it is used. The information collected is generally aggregated and used solely to improve the performance and functionality of the Platform. Examples include:

- number of visitors;
- most visited pages;
- time spent on pages;
- browser and device information; and
- performance metrics.

These cookies are only used with your consent.

Marketing (advertising) cookies

Marketing cookies are used to deliver advertisements that are relevant to your interests and to measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. These cookies may track your browsing activities across different websites. Examples include:

- personalised advertisements;
- advertising campaign measurement;
- remarketing; and
- social media advertising.

These cookies are only used with your consent.



SECTION 04

How cookies operate

The cookies described above may be implemented in the following ways.

Session cookies	Temporary cookies that enable the Platform to function properly during your browsing session. They allow us to remember information as you move from page to page, and expire automatically when you close your browser.
Persistent cookies	Cookies that remain on your device after your browsing session has ended. They help us remember your preferences, improve your experience on future visits, and analyse usage. They expire automatically after a specified period, or may be deleted through your browser settings.
Third-party cookies	Cookies placed by trusted third-party service providers whose services are integrated into the Platform — such as analytics providers, advertising networks, social media platforms, or embedded content providers. These third parties may collect information in accordance with their own privacy and cookie policies.

SECTION 05

Managing your cookie preferences

When you first visit the Platform, you will be presented with a cookie banner that allows you to:

- accept all cookies;
- reject all non-essential cookies; or
- customise your cookie preferences.

You may withdraw or modify your consent at any time through the Cookie Preferences section available on the Platform. Withdrawing consent does not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdrew it.

SECTION 06

Why AFRIKARS uses cookies

We want to provide a good customer experience on the Platform. The following are examples of how cookies allow that to happen.

Experience	To remember the quotes you have completed, so that the process is easier when you return to the Platform.
Content	To show you relevant content, such as available offers, based on how you have browsed.
User behaviour	Analytics that track visits and clicks for the pages visited. This allows us to see how our customers like to use the Platform and which pages or functions they prefer, so that we can continually improve our service.
Third party	Selected partner cookies which track where a visit originated. This allows us to see where your visit came from — particularly advertising on partner sites — to present appropriate offers, and to help prevent fraud and detect spammers.

Why do I need to know this?

AFRIKARS respects customer concerns, and we want you to know why we ask you to opt in and accept cookies. Accepting cookies does not give us access to your computer, or to any files or information stored on it. It does allow us to collect the information described in this policy and in our Privacy Policy. We value our customer relationships, and we believe our customers benefit from cookies that enhance their experience of the Platform.

SECTION 07

How to control and delete cookies

If you wish to restrict or block the cookies set by AFRIKARS — or indeed by any other website — you can do this through your browser settings. The "Help" function within your browser should tell you how.
